- ✓ Conditions, such as Inflammatory Bowel Diseases
- ✓ Healthcare or public safety workers who've ever had a "sharps" accident

Why Get Tested?

Two in three people in the U.S have Hepatitis C. And most of them don't know it. Hepatitis C often has no symptoms until the late stages, when irreversible liver damage can occur. If left untreated, Hepatitis C can cause liver cancer, cirrhosis, and chronic liver disease.

It's quick and easy. We use a rapid test that only requires a simple blood draw.

Peace Of mind. If you know you're Hepatitis C negative, you no longer have to worry about it. If you know you're Hepatitis C positive, you can take the necessary steps to get treatment and stay healthy.

It's curable, if it's caught early. New drugs can eliminate Hepatitis C, and don't have the side effects that older drugs did.

Protect friends and family. Did you know that Hepatitis C can be spread by sharing razors and toothbrushes, or by having sex with an infected person? Protect your loved ones by knowing your status.
